

Warwick Forestry Committee

The Forestry Committee is appointed by the Selectboard to manage the five town forests: The 89-acre Town Forest, the 53-acre Allen Lot, the 22-acre Sara Hayes Lot, the 80-acre Wilbur Lot, and the 1.3-acre Town Gravel lot. Each of these properties represents a significant town asset. The way the town manages and utilizes these properties sets an example to private landowners for management of renewable resources, recreation and historical significance. The committee has an ongoing process of establishing boundary lines and implementing forest management plans for these town-owned lands. Since 2002, timber sales have generated over \$40k in revenues. Additional timber sales are anticipated in the future. Citizens with an interest in our town forests are encouraged to contact the committee.
