ARTICLE 2: Shall the Town borrow \$30,000 to fund the Broadband Enterprise Fund startup capital expenses? (two-thirds vote required)

ARTICLE 3: Shall the Town borrow \$130,000 to fund repairs of the Warwick Community School automatic sprinkler system? (two-thirds vote required)
